HISTORY

Jacqueline Vergez, committed to making a difference for children and being passionate about dance, created JV Outreach, to give children who want to dance the opportunity to do so and to introduce dance to those who would otherwise not be exposed to dance.

JV Outreach established its 501C(3) in 2004 and initiated its service to the community at Waller Park Recreation Center. Over the years, services have included afterschool dance programs at Middle Schools and High Schools in North Fulton County; spring programs and dance programs at a variety of venues including DanceFx Atlanta and Tolbert Yilmaz School of Dance. JV Outreach provides dance classes as part of the Physical Education programs in several schools and impacted over 1,700 students in 2013, introducing large groups to different styles of dance, many for the first time. JV Outreach has also included a performance dance group, which has performed in front of large audiences including Festival Peachtree Latino at Piedmont Park and Roswell Cultural Arts Center.
